#### PARENT AGREEMENT FORM

We consider it a privilege to have the opportunity to send our child(ren) to Bible Baptist Academy and shall attempt to support and uphold the principles, practices, and educational policies of the school in every way.

We give permission for our child(ren) to take part in all school activities, including sports and school sponsored trips away from the school premises. We absolve the school from all liability to us or our child(ren) because of any injury to our child at school or during any school activity.

We agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of Bible Baptist Academy by providing a quiet place at home for our child(ren) to study and by giving our child(ren) encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments.

We recognize that for our child(ren) to make good progress in his work, it is essential that he have confidence in his teacher and the school. Therefore, we will do all in our power to see that our child(ren) respects and obeys the school staff and BBA rules. We agree that if our child(ren) should become involved in any difficulty with other children or the school, we will not complain to any parent or other person, but with a prayerful Christian spirit, will register necessary concerns with the proper school personnel and, according to Matthew 18, will attempt to resolve the differences.

We hereby invest authority in the school to discipline our child(ren) as necessary. We further agree to cooperate with the school and discipline our child(ren) in the home.

We understand that the school reserves the right to expel any student who does not cooperate (or whose parents do not cooperate) with the total educational process of Bible Baptist Academy. BBA does not tolerate profanity, immorality, blatant disrespect to school personnel, or any conduct that dishonors God or His Word.

We understand that students will be subject to discipline or dismissal, if, during the off school hours, they engage in conduct that violates Biblical principles, are dishonoring to God, or cast a poor reflection on the name and reputation of Bible Baptist Academy.

We understand that it is our obligation to ensure that our child(ren) arrives at school on time each day. We further understand that it is our responsibility to see that regular attendance is maintained and that if our child(ren) accumulates more than 15 absences in the school year, he may not receive credit. He may have to repeat the grade or repeat the class(es) depending on the grade level.

We pledge to pay our financial obligations to the school regularly and on time. We understand that our tuition payments are due on or before the first day of each month and that any account not paid on or before the eleventh day of the month will be assessed a \$20.00 late fee (per month). Further, we understand that if our family's account is over one month in arrears (two months due) our child(ren) could be dismissed from the school and that no report cards or school records will be released until bills are paid. We also agree to pay for any damages to school property for which our child(ren) is responsible.

We understand that when a student is withdrawn or expelled, the current month's charges are due and payable and will not be refunded.

We understand that the school requires weekly and regular church attendance in a church where God's Word is preached, believed, and obeyed. We further understand that students in  $7^{th} - 12^{th}$  grade are required to turn in a weekly accountability form that their pastor or youth pastor has signed, stating that they had attended church services that week.

We have read the BBA *Parent/Student Handbook*. We concur with it and agree to see to it that our child(ren) follows it. We have read the Statement of Faith and give our permission to the school to teach this doctrine to our child(ren).
